1) Identify the **actual URL** of a link: Pay attention only to the **who-section!**

2) Do not enter any information if an **IP address** is provided:

✘ <https://95.130.22.98/google.de.secure-login.de>

3) Do **not be fooled** by URLs, which contain the institution's name outside the who-section:

✘ <https://www.amazon.com.bestonlineshops.com/>

✘ <http://bestonlineshops.com/https://www.amazon.com>

4) Carefully examine the who-section for **typos and inverted letters**:

✘ <https://www.reaaltorr.com/>

5) Carefully examine the who-section for the use of **similar looking letters and numbers**:

✘ <https://www.instagramarn.com/>

6) Carefully check whether the who-section is a **modification** of the known and trusted who-section. If you are unsure, use a search engine.
